Summary Update Iwi Prototypes

Second Iwi Prototype with Toitū Tairāwhiti signed on 11 May 2022 for a total investment of \$55m to deliver up to 150 affordable rent-to-buy homes in the Tairāwhiti / Bay of Plenty area. The Programme Development Partnership Agreement was signed on 2 June 2022.



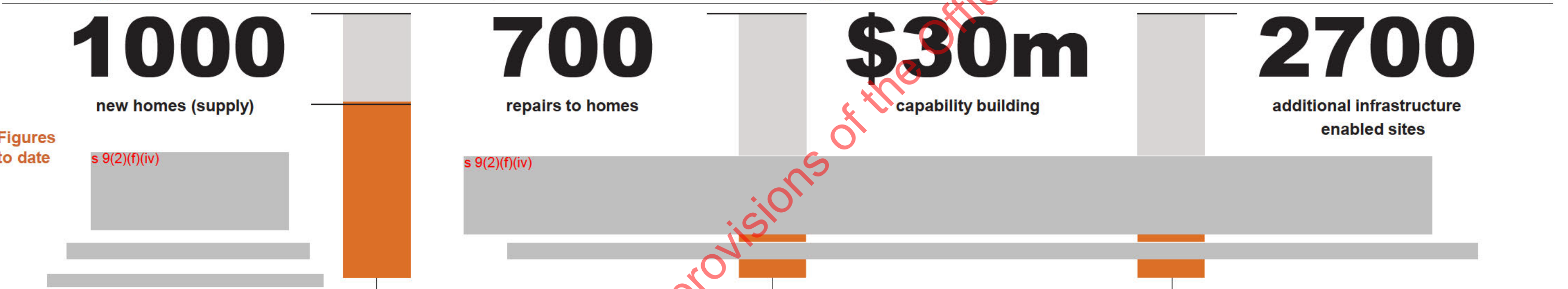
