The housing supply and affordability investment package

The housing supply and affordability investment package will increase pace, scale, diversity, and affordability of new housing supply.

The additional investment is required as the market is not delivering the volume or kind of housing supply we need in the right places.

Those houses that are currently being built by the market are not at prices low to moderate income households can afford, for renting, or for home ownership.

The government is playing a strategic role to drive delivery of housing in the right places, of the right type and the right price.




For Māori led housing development and whare repairs, as well as technical support and capability building for Māori housing providers
