On 8 November 2024 Te Tūāpapa Kura Kāinga – Ministry of Housing and Urban Development (the Ministry) received your request for the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

- A breakdown of all claimant funding for the Waitangi Tribunal Kaupapa Inquiries activities for the 2015 to 2023 financial years broken down by the various activities being funded e.g. travel, food accommodation, etc
- The number of claimants receiving regular funding payments, the amount of those payments, and the duration for which those payments are being made.

This part of your request was transferred to the Ministry by Te Arawhiti – Office of Māori Crown Relations because the information requested aligns more closely with the functions of this agency.
