Implementation of Te Maihi o te Whare Māori: Report back

Portfolio **Housing**

On 29 September 2021, the Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee (SWC):

- 1 **noted** that in May 2020, Cabinet agreed that the Māori and Iwi Housing Innovation (MAIHI) Framework for Action be applied to policy and investment decisions and implementation of housing solutions for Māori, agreed that the Associate Minister for Housing (Māori Housing) (the Minister) establish MAIHI Whare Wānanga, and invited the Minister to report back by June 2021 on progress [CAB-20-MIN-0229.02];
- 2 **noted** the 12-month progress update on the MAIHI Framework for Action and its implementation, set out in the paper under SWC-21-MIN-0148;
- 3 **noted** that the Minister will be in a position to report back on the new Māori Housing Strategy, progress of Whai Kāinga Whai Oranga and the MAIHI Framework for Action at Waitangi 2022;
- 4 **invited** the Minister to report back to SWC by 30 June 2022 on further progress of the MAIHI Framework for Action and implementation.
