Māori Housing Strategy: Maihi Ka Ora: Phase One

Portfolio Associate Housing (Māori Housing)

On 15 September 2021, the Cabinet Business Committee:

- 1 **noted** that there is inequity for Māori in Housing;
- 2 **noted** that in June 2021, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee agreed to the development of a draft Māori Housing strategy, and invited the Associate Minister for Housing (Maori Housing) to report back in August 2021 [DEV-21-MIN-0112];
- 3 **noted** that the paper under CBC-21-SUB-0098 sets out phase one of the development of the Māori Housing Strategy – Maihi Ka Ora (Maihi Ka Ora);
- 4 **noted** the shared vision for the future of Māori housing is ‘All whanau have safe, healthy, affordable homes with secure tenure, across the Māori continuum’;
- 5 **noted** that the Maori Iwi Housing Innovation (MAIHI) Framework for Action has been elevated and provides the strategic direction and framework for Maihi Ka Ora;
- 6 **noted** that Maihi Ka Ora has been written in partnership with Māori;
- 7 **noted** that the priority areas Maihi Ka Ora will focus on are:
 - 7.1 Māori Crown partnerships;
 - 7.2 Māori-led local solutions;
 - 7.3 Māori housing supply;
 - 7.4 Māori housing support;
 - 7.5 Māori housing system;
 - 7.6 Māori housing sustainability;
- 8 **approved** the release of phase one of Maihi Ka Ora, attached as annex 1 under CBC-21-SUB-0098;
- 9 **agreed** to the development of phase two of Maihi Ka Ora which will involve the development of a detailed implementation programme, co-designed with Māori, that will provide further clarity around the work programme, scope of the reviews, roles and responsibilities and measurable outcomes and targets;

- 10 **invited** the Associate Minister for Housing (Māori Housing) to report back to Cabinet:
- 10.1 in December 2021 on phase two of Maihi Ka Ora;
 - 10.2 in June 2022 on the progress of Maihi Ka Ora;
- 11 **agreed** to review Maihi Ka Ora every 3 years, in line with the review of the Government Policy Statement on Housing and Urban Development.
