### Kāinga Ora-Homes and Communities Bill: Approval for Introduction

**Portfolio**                      **Housing and Urban Development**

On 27 May 2019, following reference from the Cabinet Legislation Committee, Cabinet:

- 1        **noted** that the Kāinga Ora-Homes and Communities Bill (the Bill) holds a category 2 priority on the 2019 Legislation Programme (must be passed in the year);
- 2        **noted** that the purpose of the Bill is to establish Kāinga Ora - Homes and Communities and provide for a Government Policy Statement for Housing and Urban Development (the GPS);
- 3        **approved** the Kāinga Ora-Homes and Communities Bill [PCO 22017/5.0] for introduction, subject to the final approval of the government caucuses and sufficient support in the House of Representatives;
- 4        **agreed** that the Bill be introduced on 27 May 2019;
- 5        **agreed** that the Bill has its first reading under urgency;
- 6        **agreed** that the government propose that the Bill be:
  - 6.1      referred to the Environment Committee for consideration;
  - 6.2      enacted by 1 October 2019.
