Māori Housing Strategy: MAIHI Ka Ora – Phase Two: Implementation Plan

Portfolio Associate Housing (Māori Housing)

On 15 December 2021, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee:

- 1 **noted** that in September 2021, the Cabinet Business Committee:
 - 1.1 approved the release of phase one of MAIHI Ka Ora, and agreed to the development of phase two;
 - 1.2 invited the Associate Minister for Housing (Māori Housing) to report back in December 2021 on phase two;

- 2 **noted** that the paper under DEV-21-SUB-0276 is phase two of the development of the National Māori Housing Strategy – MAIHI Ka Ora (the Strategy);
- 3 **noted** that the shared vision for the future of Māori housing is ‘All whanau have safe, healthy, affordable homes with secure tenure, across the Māori housing continuum’;
- 4 **noted** that the MAIHI Framework for Action has been elevated and provides the strategic direction and framework for the Strategy;
- 5 **agreed** to implement phase two of the Strategy, attached as Annex 1 to the submission under DEV-21-SUB-0276;
- 6 **agreed** to review the Strategy and the Implementation Plan, attached as Annex 2 to the submission under DEV-21-SUB-0276, every three years in conjunction with the review of the Government Policy Statement on Housing and Urban Development (GPS-HUD);
- 7 **invited** the Associate Minister for Housing (Māori Housing) to report back to Cabinet in June 2022 on the progress of the Strategy.
