Thank you for your email to Kāinga Ora – Homes and Communities on 18 March 2022 requesting information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act). Kāinga Ora transferred the following part to Te Tūāpapa Kura Kāinga – Ministry of Housing and Urban Development (the Ministry) on 23 March 2022:

All and any statistics, correspondence and documentation around severe housing depravation and homelessness in Ruapehu.

We produce a series of resources that track our progress on public and transitional housing supply, homelessness programmes and other housing support. One of the resources we publish quarterly are the Public Housing Regional Factsheets, which provide a localised view of each Territorial Authority in Aotearoa New Zealand, including Ruapehu District. These reports are published on the Ministry's website here: www.hud.govt.nz/research-and-publications/statistics-and-research/public-housing-reports/.

On its website, the Ministry has published heatmaps of housing outcomes across Aotearoa, including severe housing deprivation by Territorial Authority. These maps show how places are performing relative to specific benchmarks and to one another.
