Thank you for your email of 24 September 2024 to the Department of Prime Minister and Cabinet (DPMC) requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

*May I please get the data for each of the charts in each PDF in spreadsheet form? E.g for the first target can I please get a spreadsheet for all values including estimated?*

*Can I also please have the criteria you have used to assign On Track, Probable, Feasible, At Risk and Unachievable rankings?*

On 30 September 2024, this request was partially transferred to Te Tūāpapa Kura Kāinga – Ministry of Housing and Urban Development (the Ministry), as it relates to Target 8, a 75 percent reduction of households in Emergency Housing, as we are jointly responsible for this target with the Ministry of Social Development (MSD).

On 2 October 2024, this request was also partially transferred to the Ministry from MSD for response, as the data is held by this Ministry.

I am releasing to you the data that was used to produce the Target 8 quarterly progress fact sheet in the attached Excel document. Please note that the Target includes households receiving Emergency Housing Special Needs Grants (EH SNG) and households in Contracted Emergency Housing (CEH), which is only available in Rotorua and began in July 2021.

It is also important to note that the reporting on EH SNG households was only developed in December 2020, so the figures prior to this are derived from the number of grants issued.

I am refusing the second part of your request, for the criteria used to assign rankings, under section 18(e) of the Act, on the grounds that that the document alleged to contain the information requested does not exist or, despite reasonable efforts to locate it, cannot be found. The decision regarding what status to assign this Target was based on discussion between Deputy Chief Executives based on guidance provided by DPMC.

You have the right to seek an investigation and review of my response by the Ombudsman, in accordance with section 28(3) of the Act. The relevant details can be found on the Ombudsman's website at: [www.ombudsman.parliament.nz](http://www.ombudsman.parliament.nz).

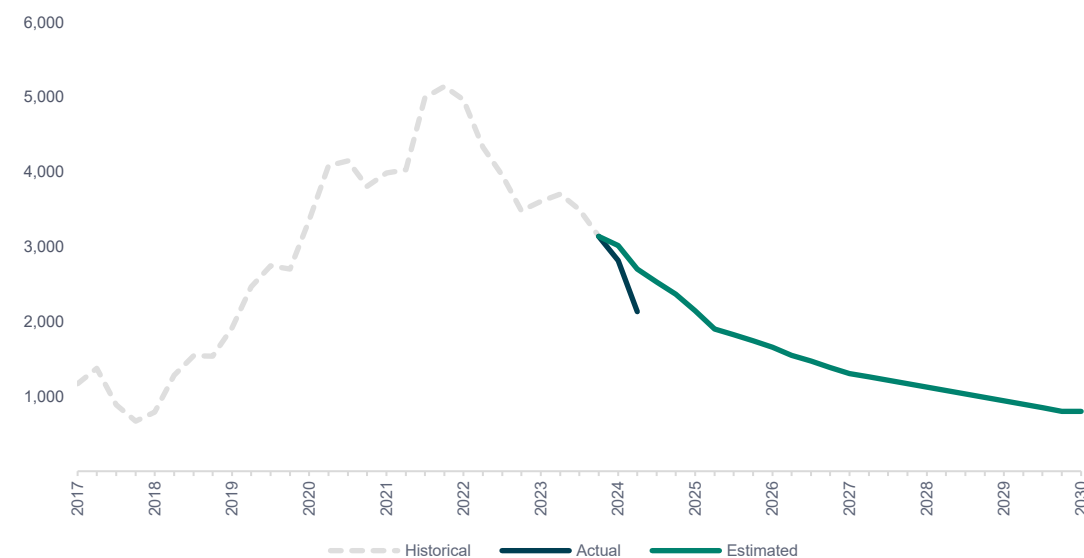
