

MAIHI and Place-	Auckland Future Development Strategy (FDS)	Auckland Future Development Strategy (FDS)
Based Work	 The National Policy Statement on Urban Development (NPS-UD) requires Tier 1 and 2 councils to prepare an FDS in time to inform their 2024 Long-term Plans. Auckland Council has approved a draft FDS 2023-2053 to publicly consult on in June. Te Tūāpapa Kura Kāinga has led limited engagement with Auckland Council. Te Tūāpapa Kura Kāinga is now reviewing the draft FDS to assess whether it meets the NPS-UD requirements and appropriately supports urban development and spatial priorities areas that align with central government investment priorities. 	Te Tūāpapa Kura Kāinga will continue to work with Auckland Council officers to help shape the final FDS, and if necessary, will make a submission.
Urban	Severe Weather Recovery Legislation Act	Severe Weather Recovery Legislation Act
Development and Reform	 An Order in Council (OIC) to permit temporary accommodation under the Resource Management Act is being developed. This will be in tranche 3 of the OICs to be enacted after approval by Cabinet on 7 August 2023. The initial documents for this work have been lodged with the Department of Prime Minister and Cabinet and Crown Law to ensure that it is within the scope of the recovery legislation. The OIC will apply to Northland, Auckland, 	The Ministry for the Environment is briefing Minister Parker in seeking approval for this OIC. Minister Woods is being copied into the briefing and should receive it this week.

	National Policy Statement on Urban Development and Enabling Housing Supply legislation Te Tūāpapa Kura Kāinga made a submission on Christchurch City Council's notified plan change. This will be made public shortly.	National Policy Statement on Urban Development and Enabling Housing Supply legislation Christchurch City Council will appoint an Independent Hearings Panel, then schedule hearings on submissions received. Te Tūāpapa Kura Kāinga expects the first hearings to be held in October 2023.
